- Medieval fortress in the beautiful surroundings of the Novohradské Mountains
- New permanent interactive exhibition: Crafts below the Novohradské Mountains (official patronage of the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic) - admission free
- A permanent exhibition of South Bohemian folk-painted furniture, from the 18th and 19th century

- Outdoor sightseeing trail below the fortress, with 12 signs of the zodiac

 sculptures created as part of the International Wood Sculpture Symposia (accessible all year round without limitations)

- Accommodation for tourists near the fortress








JIHO ČESKÉ MUZEUM

- Founded in 1877
- One of the most important cultural institutions in South Bohemia, the main building of the South Bohemian Museum
- Permanent natural science, geological, archaeological, and ethnographic exposition (won the first place and the title of 'Museum Exhibition of the Year' in the National Competition of Museums called 'Gloria musaealis')
- Permanent exhibition: 'The story of the city of České Budějovice'
- Thematically diverse exhibitions throughout the year
- Accompanying events for the general public (Museum night, guided tours of exhibitions, concerts, theatres, sightseeing tours, lectures, seminars, conferences and others)
- Educational programs for schools and other groups
- Hobby clubs and associations
- Virtual tours of exhibitions, museum library, e-shop that sells publications, advice for mushroom pickers, sale of tourist items and other services


